After its Tour de Suisse, the Lucerne Meeting has returned home: the 7th Swiss Movement Disorders Symposium will be held at the Radisson Lakefront Center Lucerne, on August 27th-28th, 2015.

As usual, the meeting will start with an array of video presentations, sharpening your eye for various clinical aspects of common and less common movement disorders.

On Friday morning, we will be updated on the pathology of Parkinson's disease, discussed by Adriano Aguzzi and Heinz Reichmann, as well as the pathogenesis of Parkinson's disease, with Serge Przedborski covering the basic science and Pierre Burkhard the clinical aspects. Don't miss out on your chance to hear such outstanding and internationally renowned speakers so close to your home!

After lunch, we will learn more about research taking place in Switzerland, sponsored by Parkinson Schweiz, followed by the 2014 Movement Disorders Paper Award. After a short break, we will enjoy the next highlight, i.e. Ian McKeith discussing dementia with Lewy bodies.

The fourth and fifth lecture sessions take into account your feedback from previous meetings. These newly added chapters of our meeting will foster crosstalk between neuroscientists and clinicians, explaining the basics of neuroscience to clinicians (Christian Lüscher and Jochen Roeper) and the clinical aspects of movement disorders to basic scientists (Georg Kagi and Alain Kaelin).

Finally, Mathias Sturzenegger will highlight the most interesting developments in movement disorders that happened during the past 12 months.
